PUBLIC HEARING: The City Commission of the City of Pampa will conduct a Public Hearing at 5:30 p.m. on July 23, 2018 at City Hall, 200 W. Foster, 3rd Floor, Pampa, Texas in the City Commission Chambers. This will be a Public Hearing for the purpose of receiving public comments concerning the following request:

Pampa Independent School District requests to rezone Lots 10 through 15, Block 1; Lots 4 through 15, Block 2; and Lots 8 through 11, Block 3 of the Cole Addition to the City of Pampa, Texas formerly the grounds of Horace Mann School, from Single Family 2 Residential to Commercial. The Applicant is requesting this rezone to market the property.

All interested parties are encouraged to attend this hearing. Public comments on the proposed rezone are welcome and will be heard.
